### 1. MAYES

-Push back in Maye's latest email. Mayes states that they are giving a specific process that is in place.

### 2. LARKIN & BUSH ST PROJECTS

-719 Larkin – relocated transformer from Olive to sidewalk. Added another storefront on Olive – achieves one of our key goals. Project has improved, responded to our objectives and development principles.

1433 Bush - Fern Alley – Have taken our advice and made commercial space made larger.

Email them – recommend approval for both projects – they need to present revised plans to membership. Discussion on how to work with you to enhance public realm, follow the LPADVP.

-what do we want to achieve on Fern? Paul odriscall is doing a project on Fern as well.

-CS is recommending support. Should we push more on the alley? They are 1/4 of the alley. We would like a double width sidewalk. Sidewalk improvements—we can work with JS Sullivan for another MOH Grant – Specific boundaries.

-Larkin Development is out of CBD jurisdiction. Contract out services for the CBD?

- JS Sullivan to present at May 5<sup>th</sup> LPN Meeting. Recommend Supporting both projects.

### 3. LPN GRAPHICS

-INTERSTICE present outline of what graphics package will contain

-INTERSTICE to move forward with graphics package preparations.

Medallions –

INTERSTICE presents medallion finishes and design options. Options of what we can do – how much do we want to differentiate in each medallion? Incremental approach – How much storytelling / iconography we want to start investing into these?

-Concern: We're partially building the district – district doesn't actually exist- risk - longevity? This is an experiment on our part. How to begin – first move- polk st spine? Followed by Van Ness and Larkin?

PLACEMENT is first part of this. Four medallions on each corner. Like the idea of a narrative- provides basis for walking tours, medallions give opportunity for docents to work with.

-Bronze will last MUCH longer than any of the other options. Can be taken out and put back in. Bronze has iconic recognition.
