## 2. Fern –

- a. Drawings of alleyway proposal were reviewed in relation to DPW's Fern continuance connecting the central alley node with developer support to Polk Street.
- b. LPN will present to membership on 2/14 AD will introduce INTERSTICE to present collaborative design efforts / products with stakeholders: CBD, JS Sullivan, Celtic Development, LPN.

### 3. Hemlock East

- a. What can we do with \$100K for Hemlock / Polk intersection? (Seamus, Dolman Property Group)
- b. LPN to measure alleyway frontage to compare to alleyways district (tentative) frontage quantifier for development contributions. AD to report back on how 50K relates to other alleyway precedents.
- c. LPN identifies that this is a great corner site, similar to Olive, with a large frontage on Polk Street. LPN would like to meet with developers to design a Polk Plaza gateway at this intersection. Also lighting and potential for striping the crosswalk may be things to discuss w/ developer, implement one of the Plaques from the LGBTQ Cultural Corridor plan, (Giraffe Bar) or an LPN district marker. LPN to suggest meeting time with developer and CBD.

### 4. Olive Alley

- a. Andrew Chandler to look up grants to support developer's commitment to integrate alleyways district vision plan into their public space design along Olive.
- 5. Funding LPN grants need to structure funding.
  - a. LPN to develop a template for standard RFP in response to the Merchant's Street Improvement Grant – draft to be presented at next meeting
  - b. EW to present outreach venue for LPN to present MSIG Brief. (Abstract of RFP on splash page on LPN/CBD websites, etc.
